There was a good turn out to the Wine Store in Charlestown last week for a tasting of 6 wines, 3 white and 3 red from different regions of Italy. Gina the Sommelier, gave many interesting facts and figures on the wines and producers and even explained the wine classification system in Italy. The wines were served alongside a good selection of tapas style dishes to match, and from feedback I think everyone enjoyed the evening. Many of the members took pleasure in filling out their wine tasting notes sheet, and intend keeping them on file for future reference. With this in mind, I attach a blank wine tasting note sheet and if you wish, to print out and bring along to every tasting. At the end of the year, it is good to look back and see the variety of wines you have tasted and enjoyed (or not!), and for our members who are new to wine appreciation, the notes give names and types of grapes to look out for when shopping for a bottle of wine.
