February's walk was the Gover Valley.



13 walkers and 4 dogs covered a circular trail in just under 3 hours. The walk was about 6 miles long.



We had a gloriously sunny day to make our way along the valley then through some shady woodland eventually emerging above Trewoon.



The walk took us past old and more recent mine excavations, open cast and tin, plus flooded pits and wind turbines, energy in several forms! There were views out to the East past the Gribben and to the West over Mevagissey.



The downhill section looks us through some open fields, a hidden bridleway that appeared to be a homeowners drive and a steeper wooded section before joining the valley bottom.
