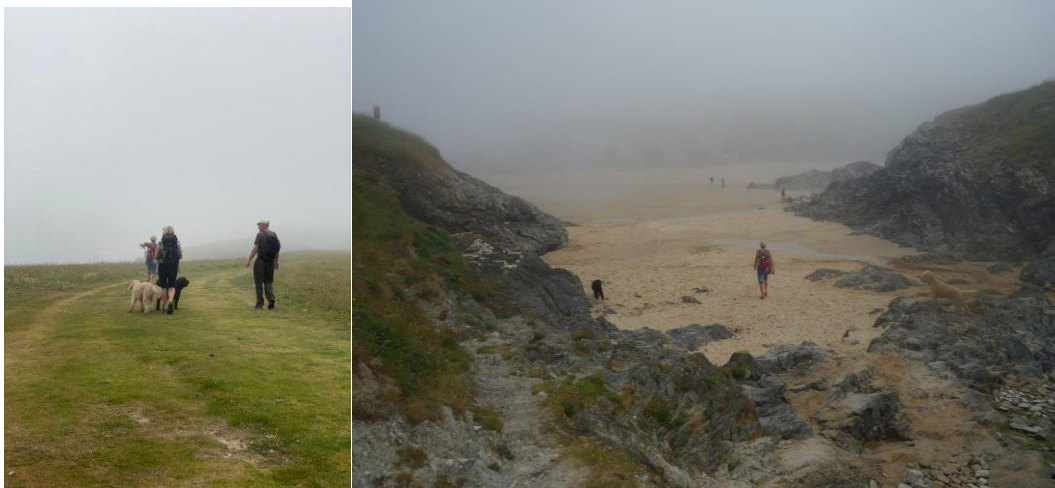


June's walk was Holywell to Polly Joke.
